Guidelines for Submitting a Grammar or Dictionary Proposal

- 1. The series aims to publish in each case either (i) a comprehensive grammar, along with a (bilingual) lexicon as an appendix or (ii) a comprehensive monolingual or bilingual dictionary, along with a sketch of the grammar of the language in question as an appendix. Please make sure that your proposal is in either of these categories.
- 2. A full manuscript should not be submitted prior to submitting a proposal. It can be submitted only after your proposal has been reviewed and approved.
- 3. A proposal should not be more than 10 pages, excluding appendices.
- 4. A proposal should include:
- i. a title of the grammar/dictionary,
- ii. the name, affiliation, email and postal addresses of the author(s),
- iii. a short introduction to the target language,
- iv. a short description/abstract of the grammar/dictinary to be written,
- v. a list of topics to be covered or tentative table of contents,
- vi. some information on competing grammars/dictionaries, if any,
- vii. a timeline for writing the grammar/dictionary,
- viii. a list of references/bibliography,
- ix. a short curriculum vitae of the author(s) including information on previous publications, if any, and, optionally,
- x. a sample chapter or any other information you consider pertinent as an appendix to the proposal.
